# B-2 Building, Equipment, Repairs and Maintenance

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### **Policy Statement**

We aim to provide a safe and secure environment through proper and immediate attention to all aspects of building and equipment repairs and maintenance.

#### **Procedure**

Equipment will be chosen to meet the children's developmental needs and interests.

Buildings, all equipment and furniture will be maintained in a safe, clean condition and in good repair at all times.

There will be no damaged plugs, sockets, power cords or extension cords. All plug sockets shall be maintained as child safe. Electrical circuit breakers will be installed and be maintained by the school.

Provision will be made in the budget for regular maintenance and repair work and for deferred costs of major capital repairs.

The Management Committee will develop a list of fully licensed and insured trades persons. The list shall be reviewed on an annual basis and made available to the Director.

All contractors should have their own public liability insurance.

The Centre and equipment will be regularly checked to ensure that they are in a good and safe condition and that they comply with Australian Standards. Appropriate soft fall surfacing will be maintained for the equipment.

Equipment will be regularly washed and cleaned.

Recycled craft materials should be checked for potential hazards.

Staff should ensure safe handling of all tools, particularly sharp tools, if used as part of any activity.

Faulty equipment will be removed, or protection placed around any dangerous building sites.

Daily hazard identification checks are completed at the beginning of each session to ensure that any risks are spotted immediately and are taken care of as soon as possible. Anything that requires maintenance is to be reported to the Director as soon as possible.

Parents will be encouraged to notify staff of any problems that they might observe.
