### **Policy Statement**

Films and videos can be used as part of the program of activities after thoughtful consideration relating to the content and message of the film. Staff will ensure all videos and films are suitable for the children's ages. We aim to develop and implement a program that is stimulating, interesting and exciting, whilst also allowing opportunities for children to experience times of relaxation and leisure.

#### **Procedure**

Movies and television watched at the Centre will only be viewed if classified as G or PG rating.

Movies and television may be used, and when used will be planned as part of a balanced program of activities. They could highlight a particular activity or interest in the program. They will not be a daily activity in the Centre.

Movies or television may be planned as part of the program during Vacation Care and will be advertised in the program to parents.

Staff should preview the movie/show where possible, beforehand. Parents will be required to sign a permission form before children can be taken to the cinemas (see Excursion Policy).

Alternative activities will always be available when movies or television is being shown, and the use of such media in the program will not replace the supervision responsibilities of the staff.

Staff will ensure children are not too close the TV screen and are at a safe distance for their eyes. Staff will ensure that the size of the screen is appropriate for the number of children watching. If it is for a large number of students, staff will ensure the movie is shown on the big screen in the hall.

Staff will ensure that sound levels are kept at acceptable limits and provision is made for children disturbed by loud sounds to have a safe, quieter place to spend time.

Alternative activities will always be available when movies or television programs are being shown, and will not replace the supervision responsibilities of the staff members.
